MASTER PLAN FOR ASPIRATIONAL DISTRICTS

BACKGROUND

1. With a focus to intervene in the backward districts which rank poorly in important social indicators, NITI Aayog identified 115 Aspirational Districts (30 districts identified by NITI Aayog, 35 Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected districts by Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and 50 by the Central Ministries) in 28 States for intervention by respective Ministries and formulated a Scheme known as “Transformation of Backward Districts in India”. These districts were selected through a transparent process based on the composite index and inputs of key Ministries by the Committee set up under Ms. Anita Karwal, then Additional Secretary, MHRD. List of identified districts is at Annexure I.
2. The scheme is to be implemented during the period 2017-18 to 2021-22. The main part of the funding would be obtained through convergence of existing schemes. However, given the current development deficit in these districts, some additional funding has been envisaged.
3. For improving the performance of the districts, focus areas has been identified as Health & Nutrition, Education, Agriculture & Water resources, Financial Inclusion & Skill Formation and Basic Infrastructure. Following is the weight given to each of them.

4. Districts are to be monitored on real time basis to capture the progress and ranked accordingly as per the above parameters. The selected districts aspire to become State's best and then Nation's best. Teams have been created at Central and State level to monitor the progress in the identified districts. At centre level, 115 Prabhari officers (Additional Secretary/Joint Secretary rank) have been appointed by Cabinet Secretariat. An Empowered Committee of Secretaries has been created to monitor the functioning of the scheme. Similarly, at State level committee has been set up under Chief Secretary and state level nodal officers/Prabhari officers have been appointed.

INDICATORS FOR MONITORING SKILL DEVELOPMENT

5. Skill development has a weight of 5% amongst the identified parameters. A set of five indicators pertaining to Skill Development has been devised by NITI Aayog to monitor the progress of the selected districts as listed below:

- District wise number of training centres under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) as on 31.03.2018 is at **Annexure II**. Under PMKVY, the training capacity changes dynamically depending on the active number of training centres under the scheme with training targets.
 - Industrial Training Institute (ITI) related information, as on February, 2018 is at **Annexure III**.
 - Polytechnic related information is at **Annexure IV**.
 - Jan Sikshan Sansthan (JSS) related information is at **Annexure V**.
 - District wise population in the age group of 15-18 and 15-34 is at **Annexure VI**.
- 6 In skilling ecosystem, the machinery at district level is primarily through Training Providers (TPs) and Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). The ITI set up is quite structured and may not allow the flexibility of taking up special initiatives in the identified districts. Keeping in view these limitations, an Action Plan has been prepared listing the strategies of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) to achieve the goals towards the transformation of Backward Districts in India.



Action Plan of MSDE

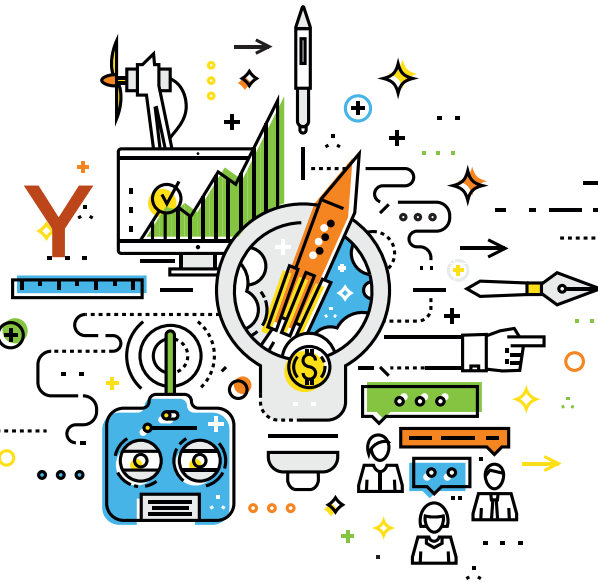
1. SATURATION OF ZERO COVERAGE DISTRICTS:

STRATEGY



STRATEGY TO SERVE THE UNSERVED DISTRICTS:

- (i) Two districts Namsai and Kiphire do not have ITIs. However, the population of these districts is 81,704 and 1,15,034 respectively. Establishing a new ITI may not be viable in these two districts. Avenues will be explored in these districts to provide training facility by initiatives like:
 - Providing hostel facility in the nearby ITIs and/or transportation facility wherever required. There exists a Govt. Polytechnic in Kiphire which can also be used for providing training. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs) will be operational in both of these districts by January 2019.
 - Mobilisation of candidates from these districts to use the above facilities through initiatives like Kaushal Melas, Common Service Centres (CSC) to bring awareness about skill development programmes. The CSCs and PMKVY centres in the nearby districts will be directed to cover the concerned districts in their quarterly Kaushal Melas. The upcoming PMKKs in these districts, once operational, ought to conduct Kaushal Melas at least once every six months in coordination with State/Local representatives.
 - Opening of PMKVY centre for short term training and converge with centres under other Central Government schemes like Deen dayal Upadhyaya- Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), NULM etc.
- (ii) 121 PMKKs will be established across the 115 Aspirational districts in the country. Of these, 78 PMKKs have been operationalised, 14 more PMKKs will be operationalised by September 2018. 29 more PMKKs will be operationalised by January, 2019 which will

serve as nodal and aspirational skill centres thereby achieving 100% coverage of the Aspirational districts by PMKKs. Since, all districts will have PMKKs by January, 2019 the 100% coverage of the districts by PMKVY will get achieved automatically. The district wise details of PMKK are at Annexure VII.

2. CREATION OF DISTRICT ACTION PLAN :

District Action Plans for each district will be prepared to identify skill gaps & accordingly provide skilling facilities. These are being prepared for 13 districts of Uttarakhand, on pilot basis. After successful completion of pilot in next few months, district action plan for the Aspirational districts will be undertaken on priority. Estimated time to complete the exercise of creating district action plan for all the Aspirational districts is January, 2019.

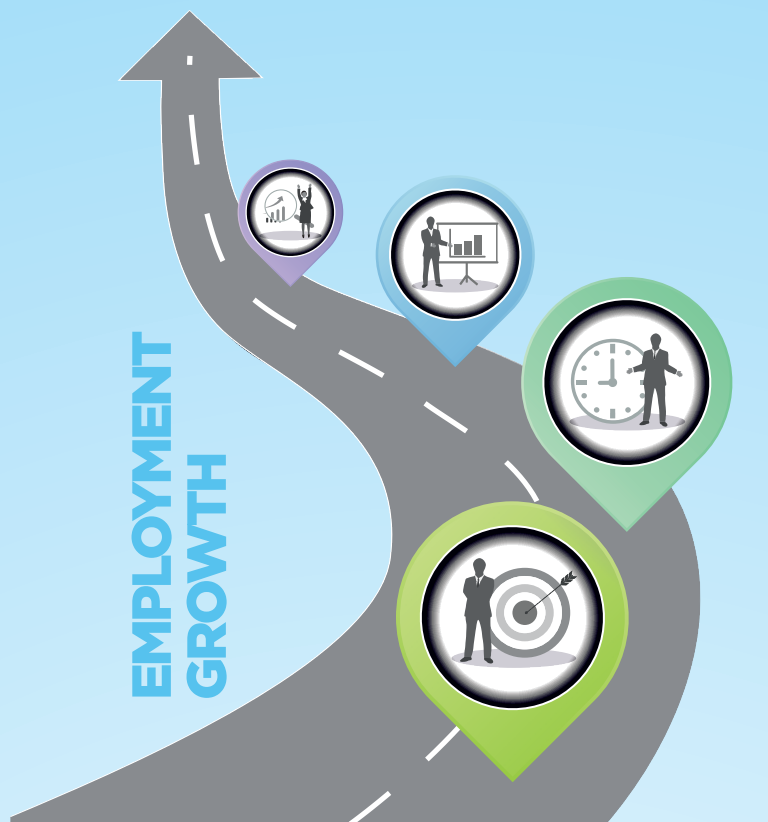
Funds will be released through the following schemes:

- i. Funds under LWE scheme will be utilized for undertaking study in LWE districts.
- ii. Funds under "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in North Eastern States & Sikkim" scheme will be utilized for undertaking study in North East districts.
- iii. For remaining districts, funds will be allocated through Skills Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP) project.

3. IMPROVING EMPLOYMENT RATES :

In the year 2017-18, 1,60,876 candidates were trained under PMKVY in the Aspirational districts with a placement percentage of 35%. MSDE will ensure that





these training numbers are increased by at least 20% in the Aspirational districts in 2018-19, and also an increased placement is achieved.

MSDE has taken the following measures to enhance employment outcomes in under PMKVY :

- i. **Rozgar Mela** : Increase number of job fairs with more focus on outcome. In this respect, a three tier strategy has been developed for increasing the reach of such job fairs along with ensuring employment being the key outcome. Over 2000 Rozgar Melas will be organised by National Skill Development Council (NSDC), Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) and Training Partners from May, 2018 to March, 2019. Month wise details are at **Annexure VIII**.
- ii. **Placement performance as key evaluation parameter:**
While evaluating performance of training centre, employment rate has been kept as the key parameter. This means placements are necessary for further target allocation to training centre. The reallocation of targets will be done only to those centres which shows more than 70% placements and the centres would be incentivised on a pro rata basis on their placement numbers. In this way, Training centres will take steps to increase their placement levels in order to earn higher incentives.
- iii. **Rationalisation of job roles with respect to**

placement performance: Detailed exercise to rationalise PMKVY job roles has been undertaken, with focus on industry demand of the job roles and their Aspirational value. A list of such job-roles is being issued.

- iv. **Launch of Apprenticeship linked and apprenticeship embedded job-roles in PMKVY:**
In order to improve the industry exposure, PMKVY job role linkage with Apprenticeship has been strengthened. In addition, apprenticeship embedded courses have been started in PMKVY where apprenticeship is an integral component of PMKVY. The Training Providers would be able to register their candidates on the Apprenticeship portal where they'll be provided with apprenticeship opportunities and assured jobs. Since apprenticeship embedded courses enhance industry exposure and ensure placement of the candidate, the centres will inherently be encouraged to adopt more of such courses.

4. **PMKK to act as Counselling/Aptitude Testing centres:**

PMKK as an Aspirational centre are useful to do advocacy in the district. PMKK guidelines prescribe that a minimum of 75 sq. feet dedicated space is mandatorily required for counselling in every PMKK. The space is used to provide counselling to parents as well as aspirants.

- i. The dedicated space available within the centre will be used for counselling in every PMKK.
- ii. PMKK will provide counselling and advocacy on various other schemes related to skill development in coordination with training provider.
- iii. On weekends, PMKK space can be utilized to conduct aptitude test in coordination with Training provider where interest mapping will be done for the interested candidates available in the district. SSC will support the district authorities.

Consultation on the same has started and a team has been formed in NSDC to look into it. Strategy on how to convert PMKKs as nodal counselling centres for the district will be finalized in 6 months.



5. Re-allocation under State Component:

A circular has been issued by MSDE to all the States allowing them to provide 25% more funds for Aspirational districts out of the funds provided to them under Centrally Sponsored and State Managed (CSSM) component of PMKVY. A copy of the same is attached at **Annexure IX**.

6. Special Projects:

'Special Projects' is a demand driven component of the scheme and its implementation is based on the proposals received. Currently under the special projects category 27 out of 115 Aspirational districts are covered. The sectors in which the training is being conducted include Automotive, Plumbing, IT, Textiles & Handloom, Retail, Green Jobs, Apparel, Handicraft, Agriculture, Telecom.

The 'Special Projects' proposals submitted by District Administration will be considered under this component and shall be processed by NSDC on priority.

7. Assistance provided under Mudra Loans:

TPs/TCs will continue to be encouraged to connect trained candidates with Mudra Loan Scheme. The mapping of candidates who have received Mudra Loan for short term training or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), as reported by TPs is attached at **Annexure X**.

8. To fast track the interventions and ensure that they have desired impact, handholding through identified agencies will be provided at district level. The envisaged role of the agency would be as follows:

i. Baseline Survey in the identified districts indicating parameters relating to training like- number of candidates who have undergone the training, placements post training, training demand in that district, potential for RPL, presence of industry (large & MSME), career counselling facilities, opportunities for Apprenticeship placements in the region etc.

ii. Facilitation of:

a) Mobilisation of candidates for training as per their interest/ local demand

b) Counselling

c) Connecting them with training centres concerned

d) Monitoring training

e) Linking with industry for Apprenticeship and employment/ Mudra loan for self employment

iii. Monitoring the progress in performance.

9. The progress on the above Action Plan will be updated periodically.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: - Enable and strengthen skill development activities under PMKVY – CSSM component in aspirational districts– reg.

Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship along with state governments are undertaking skill development activities under Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) component of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY). States have been allocated physical targets and corresponding funds for a period of 4 years. State Governments must have uniformly distributed the physical targets across districts based on the district level demand and supply estimations as well as due considerations of relevant socio-economic parameters. 115 aspirational districts (list enclosed) have been identified by Govt. of India where concerted efforts are required to improve the employability of the youth residing there.

In this context, it has been decided that under the PMKVY – CSSM component, additional 25% funds and corresponding physical targets will be targeted for the aspirational districts by reducing the proportionate funds and targets from other districts in the state.

It is advised that the states involve the district collectors to increase the awareness about the scheme to identify skill gaps for the district, to facilitate mobilization of beneficiaries, to undertake monitoring activities and to support in job creation for the youth post completion of skill development programs. State Governments are requested to issue guidelines to the district administration to ensure smooth implementation of the above initiatives in order to achieve the desired outcomes.

MSDE will closely work with the state governments to achieve this.
