Indian Economy: High Growth but severe development Challenges



Why this programme?

- India on high growth trajectory.
- But Low Human Development Index: **Ranked 131 of 188 nations in 2016**
- Significant variations: Inter-State, inter-district.
- **Aspirational District Programme launched to transform pockets of under-development.**

Special focus on health, nutrition, education, agriculture needed for *sabka saath sabka vikaash*.

Nutrition: Current Status

- **Improving nutrition is key task.**
- **Special mission to improve nutrition launched.**

However, challenges are huge:


- **One in every 2 women is anaemic**
- **One in every 3 children is stunted**
- **One in every 4 children is Malnourished**
- **One in every 5 children is Wasted**
















Per cent of government school children in **Std V** who can read **Std II level text**







A NEW INDIA by 2022

The Indian economy is on a high growth trajectory. However, it ranked 131 out of 188 nations in UNDP's Human Development Index 2016. Its performance in terms of improving quality of life for its citizen is not consistent with its growth story. While different States have their unique strengths, they face challenges in improving health, education, basic infrastructure etc. for their citizens. Within States too,

there are major variations. Some districts have done well whereas some have faced challenges. It is important that a concerted effort is made to improve performance of districts which are pockets of under-developments. This will result in a dramatic rise in ranking of the country in terms of HDI and would also help the country in achieving SDGs. This will be a step towards creation of a New India by 2022.




